<p><b>Course Description:</b></p> <p>When children and adolescents come to counseling for support with trauma and abuse that they have experienced, clinicians can be at a loss for how best to work with the complexities and the intensity of their clients' experiences. Without a clear understanding of what to do and how to facilitate the integration of children's traumas, children can stay stuck and unable to move forward in their healing. Clinicians can also find themselves anxious, exhausted, confused, overwhelmed and dysregulated, which can over time significantly impact their longevity in the field, as well as their ability to stay attuned and present to the child.</p> <p>With the help of neuroscience and a Synergetic Play Therapy framework, this two-day workshop will teach clinicians how to effectively work with trauma and abuse in a way that supports integration, nervous system regulation, and decreases compassion fatigue and vicarious trauma.</p>	
<p>Objectives:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Learn the 4 major perceived threats of the brain</li> <li>2. Discuss the significance of congruence and authentic expression with children</li> <li>3. Learn the link between a child's dysregulated states of their nervous system and their traumatic experiences</li> <li>4. Learn how to recognize dysregulation in a child's behaviors and play</li> <li>5. Discuss the Synergetic Play Therapy concept of "The Set Up" as a way to understand what a child is attempting to communicate</li> <li>6. Learn what it takes to become a child's external regulator to help them develop a stronger regulatory capacity</li> <li>7. Learn how to work with traumatic play without having the clinician's own nervous system shut down</li> <li>8. Learn how to set boundaries without shaming the child</li> </ol>	



**Note:**

1. Application for accreditation should be filed 45 days before the offering of the program/training.
